# **STAY HOME!**



#### **Cover your mouth!**

• Germs, viruses, and bacteria can easily travel several feet when you cough or sneeze.

• They can also live 2-3 hours on most surfaces.



# Wash and disinfect your hands often and thoroughly.



## When should you wash?

- Before and after preparing food.
- Before eating food.
- Before and after caring for someone who is sick.
- After using the toilet.
- After changing diapers or cleaning up a child who has used the toilet.
- After blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.



#### How to wash your hands

- Wet your hands with clean, running water (warm or cold) and apply soap.
- Rub your hands together to make a lather and scrub them well; be sure to scrub the backs of your hands, between your fingers, and under your nails.





#### How to wash your hands

- Continue rubbing your hands for at least 20 seconds.
- Rinse your hands under running water.
- Dry your hands using a clean towel or air dry them.
- Be careful what you touch with those clean hands (sink and door handles).





# **Fire in the Building**

Have a prearranged designated meeting place and know your evacuation routes. Communicate them regularly to your class.

- Check to feel if the door is hot.
- Avoid heavy smoke.
- Calmly evacuate using posted routes.
- Have roster and do a headcount at the determine meeting location.



#### **Severe Weather**

- Get indoors into hallways or interior rooms of building or a designated shelter area.
- -Stay away from windows.
- –Cover head and squat on the floor facing the wall.
- –Keep track of children and speak calmly.
- –Follow safety announcements from chapel staff.





#### **Active Shooter**

- During a shooting incident, your first action should be to ESCAPE or EVACUATE from the scene, if possible.
- If unable to escape, lock and barricade door.
- Don't have anybody visible through the classroom door glass.
- Call 911 after everyone is secure.
- Fight AGGRESSIVELY if confronted.
- Wait for law enforcement instructions.
