EAT, MEET, PRAY

A monthly meal where Life Groups LIVE out community. Groups meet to eat and pray for each other. Monthly meals can be small or big, in a home, at chapel, or at a park. Life Group Hosts coordinate to fit the personality of your Life Group.

STUDY THE BIBLE

We want people to LEARN the richness of God's Word, and how it applies to their lives. Life Groups meet at least twice a month for Bible study. Each group decides what time is best for their group. A Life Group allows for great discussion on God's Word to take place.

WORSHIP

MINISTRY ROLES

LIFE GROUP HOST

BIBLE STUDY TEACHER/FACILITATOR
