BRIEFING FOR SR. CHAPLAINS

Subject: Trunk of Treat sponsored by RSO at Main Post Chapel

Objective: To provide a safe, positive, family friendly opportunity for children to participate in trick or treating while at the same time sharing the gospel message and informing the community about Chapel services and RSO programs.

Who: Chapel families and youth will host decorated trunks on the theme: children's movies. They are encouraged to make their trunk interactive with a game/activity for the children to play as they receive their treats.

What: Trick or Treating families/children will park in the west parking lot and in the Rec Plex parking lot and enter the north parking lot through the two drive ways.

- 1. There will be volunteers at the entry point to give families a bag to collect treats in and the bag will contain a gospel tract, an invitation to chapel services and upcoming events such as Christmas Eve service and flyers about other RSO opportunities such as PWOC, CWOC, YOC and CYOC, and Christ Fit with winter session dates.
- 2. Families will receive a ballot to vote for their three favorite trunks, and guess the number weight of a pumpkin on display. The ballots will be collected as they leave. Door prizes will be given away by pulling names from ballots and the guess closest to the weight of the pumpkin will win the pumpkin. The families will be contacted by email that evening after the event.
- 3. A food area will be set up with a few tables and chairs where families can get a hotdog, chips and hot chocolate.
- 4. Families will be invited to stay for the Crossroads service at 1700 in Main Post Chapel

Where: North parking lot at Main Post Chapel

When: Sunday, 27 October, Set up at 1400-1500 and TorT 1500-1700

How: Crossroads service participants will assist as a community outreach, YOC and CYOC will assist with the event as a service project.

- 1. The DRE will make announcements at all the chapels inviting families to host a trunk or to come enjoy the fun.
- Trunk registration forms will be available at all chapels and at the RSO with registration required by Tuesday, October 22 COB. The goal is to involve a minimum of 25 trunks.
