SUMMARY:

On 25 March 2018 the members of the USAG Brussels Chapel Family participated in a Messianic Seder Celebration.

Impact:

- 1. Telling the Passover Story with the full meal (using all five senses) reinforces the fact that God has always provided redemption for His people.
- A recreation of the Last Supper demonstrates how every element of the Seder meal has a direct correlation to the death and resurrection of Jesus and the gift of unconditional forgiveness for all who believe.
- Jesus demonstrated servant leadership during the Last supper (washing the disciple's feet) and that concept was emphasized during the hand washing portion of the Brussels Seder meal.
- 4. The Messianic Seder Celebration prepared the Brussels Chapel Family for Holy Week and Easter.
