Purpose

Multi-Faith Group Resources

A number of pre-developed resources were compiled to create a "multi-faith" resource guide that will assist Unit Ministry Teams in providing religious education resources for a variety of faith groups. These resources provide quality websites, publishers, organizations, specific materials, and contacts that will assist chapel faith groups and individuals in their faith formation process and religious educational goals.

Individual Belief System Assessment Tools

In addition to the resource lists, a legal licensing agreement has been established with <u>www.selectsmart.com/religion</u> to allow the chaplaincy within the USAG Grafenwoehr Garrison footprint, to print and use the 27 world religion definitions in conjunction with their online "Belief System Selector Quiz". These resources are provided (*as a separate file – "Belief Assessment Tool 2009"*) to assist those military personnel who <u>seek clarification of their religious beliefs</u>, and desire to find additional resources that will assist them in developing their personal spirituality and faith. Selectsmart.com has developed a "Belief System Selector Quiz" (20 questions) that helps a person clarify their present belief system and then match it with (by percentage) 27 common world religions. Additional links and resources are provided to them that will assist them in developing their "identified" belief system. This is a tremendous belief system assessment tool for individuals.
