Know Learners

- Parents will attend with their children for child protection. Involve parents in the activities.

Know the content for both stations

- Review Episcopal Lesson Plan & "Military Child Education Coalition Growing Learning Understanding" (MCEC GLU) kit.
 - Be Ready to talk about concepts with students
- Make a sample activity like the guides, or like other versions you have seen
- o You may add activities from the MCEC GLU Kit, but they need to reinforce the Christian principles in the Episcopal Lesson Plan.

Gather the resources

- Station 1 See Episcopal Lesson Plan
- Station 2 See Episcopal Lesson Plan plus make a sample activity

<u>Use Lesson Plan in Your Pocket to improve your lesson minute by the minute.</u>

- Leave worship during the last hymn & set up the classroom space for 2 activity stations before families arrive
- The stations will start as children arrive. After 20 min, take 10 min snack break, and switch stations for 20 min.

Station 1 - Reading the Bible

- Welcome & Introductions & Take attendance
- Using the Episcopal Lesson Plans, have students work together to do the activities listed in "Books to Read," "Reading the Bible," & "Book of Common Prayer."

Station 2 - Make Something Together

- Welcome & introduce each other
- Show the sample activity.
- Hand out supplies to each student. Have parents help.
- Using the Episcopal Lesson Plans, have students work together to do the activities listed in "Make Something Together" and "Talking or Writing."
- Incomplete activities can be finished at home.

Clean up the room

- Turn in any information to chaplain or Distinctive Religious Group Leader
- Put away supplies
- Clean floors and furniture
- Remove trash

Contact

- Call or email absentees ("We missed you." "Here is what you missed.")
- Remind class members of coming events
- o Coordinate with other teachers to adjust future lessons based on needs of learners and content.
