SUBJECT: Chaplain Reminders Regarding Religious Accommodation Requests

1. Purpose: To provide reminders on the chaplain's role in immunization religious accommodation requests.

2. Recommendations:

- a. According to AR 600-20, Appendix P, "Religious Accommodation" the chaplain's role is as follows: "The chaplain must provide a memorandum that summarizes this interview and addresses the religious basis and sincerity of the Soldier's request. The chaplain is not required to recommend approval or disapproval, but may do so."
- b. The chaplain has two questions to answer in the religious accommodation request interview:
 - (1) Is the request religious in nature? (AR 600-20, Appendix P-1, d. (2))
- (2) Is this a "sincerely held belief" (DoDI 1300.17) and thus a sincere request? (AR 600-20, Appendix P-1, *d.* (2))
- c. OCCH recommends that the interviewing chaplain is not the unit chaplain, but one from outside the unit and "determined by the senior chaplain" per AR 600-20, Appendix P-1, *d*. (2).
- d. OCCH requests that the chaplain at the GCMCA level forward religious accommodation packets for immunizations to OCCH for situational awareness.
